We are gathered here this evening to celebrate the hundred and eightieth anniversary of our foundation. We are very fortunate to be members of a vibrant and friendly community that provides a real sense of belonging. THE ROSSALL SCHOOL FOUNDATION


The Heritage Project will safeguard our most iconic buildings for future generations of Rossallians. The project provides an opportunity to come together as a community to ensure we leave an enduring legacy, one that will serve to inspire our boys and girls to develop a life-long appreciation of the architectural beauty that we have the privilege of enjoying.

The Heritage Project will also ensure that the buildings are fit for purpose long into the future. Safeguarding the future of these buildings will cost well in excess of £1.5 million and this does not take into account the work that needs to be carried out in order to ensure that the Sumner Library becomes a modern study space within which children can work together collaboratively.

WELCOMING UKRAINIAN CHILDREN TO ROSSALL

Since the outbreak of war, we have welcomed Ukrainian children to Rossall from Kharkiv, Mariupol, Odessa and Kyiv. The youngest was just three whilst the oldest was seventeen. Some arrived with an excellent level of English whilst others require intensive support from our excellent EAL department. The generosity of the Rossall Foundation has enabled us to provide a number of fully funded places for children displaced by the conflict. Similarly, the fundraising activities of the Rossall Rose Society have provided additional support for children who have arrived with little more than the clothes that they were wearing on the day that they left.

Our Ukrainian children have settled into school life remarkably well. Their involvement in the cultural life of the school is very impressive. Life without them is hard to imagine and yet we all hope and pray for the day when they can return to their families and help build a positive future for their country. They are courageous, resilient and determined.

Additionally, we have become an important centre for Ukrainians living here on the Fylde coast. Our Ukrainian Hub provides vital services for Ukrainian refugees which includes fortnightly social gatherings and support and guidance with regards to housing, education and employment opportunities. Furthermore, we established a Ukrainian Saturday School for local Ukrainian children. We are incredibly grateful for the partnership funding provided by Lancashire County Council which helps ensure the long term sustainability of these various projects.

The future is uncertain but our commitment to our Ukrainian families is not time bound. The last word should go to Lower Sixth Former Anastasiia Bolkhovitina who joined Rossall from a school in Kyiv:

"Being able to be a part of Rossall was life-changing for me. I was heartily welcomed and fully integrated into the school community with access to high-quality education without the necessity to think about air raid alerts and blackouts. I am really grateful for this opportunity to grow as an individual, which Ukrainians like me will always remember. My biggest aim of becoming a "life-changer" for others will be possible, because of Rossall."

The Rossallian Club is absolutely delighted to be supporting the 180th anniversary celebrations!




